

INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO MUSKAN POLYMERS

On Saturday, 25 August 2012, 19 students of B.Com Part II and COP course TTM students of IIInd year visited Muskaan Polymers, a small scale industry as a part of their Industrial tour. Their Professors Ms. Neha Mittal, Ms. Moushakhi Ray and Mr. Shomik Saha accompanied them.

Muskaan Polymers which is a plastic recycling industry is situated in Fulbari. Mr. Ajay Kedia, the proprietor said that his industry does not only address the social issue of pollution in the region but also of unemployment of unskilled middle aged workers.

Visit to Muskaan Polymers was an enlightening experience for all the students. Manish Jaiswal, a student of B.Com Part II said that “this is my first experience of this kind. I am so impressed with this form of industry that I would like to do something similar to it myself after I complete my studies”. The students learnt about the different processes involved in the recycling of plastic and the production of the final product which is plastic strings and tarpaulin sheets. After about an hour stay in the factory, we headed back to our college. This was a very fruitful experience for both the faculty members and the students.
