## SCIENCE DEPARTMENT EXCURSION – 2013

Day: 4th January, 2013

On the first day we visited the following:

- NEHU (North Eastern Hill University, a Central University) Campus
- · Don Bosco Museum at Mawlai

At NEHU, we visited the Science Centre and startled to see many scientific principles at work, many instruments etc.

Then we were fortunate to get access to the Computer Science Department and its laboratories. There we were shown the Super Computer set up by the CDAC (Centre for Development of Advanced Computing), Pune. It was a treat for our science students! Then we drove to the next destination. We had only heard about it. When we reached the Museum, it was simply awesome! We had just one hour to check out something that needs at least three hours to do justice. Three floors below ground level and four floors above! Full of artifacts, precious collections from ages past, entire history of the India's North East! Moreover, the information is all computerized and can be read from display terminals! And to top it all, there is the "Sky Walk" – on the top dome, there is a barricaded walk way leading up to the very top of the dome from where one gets the full panoramic view of Mawlai! - Elephant Falls
- NEIGRIHMS
- Ward Lake

Shillong Peak is the highest place in Shillong Valley from where one gets the bird's eye view of the City. Our students enjoyed their visit by adorning the local costumes and posing for the camera! The Elephant Falls is a three-step falls. There used to be a huge rock that was in the shape of an elephant but it was destroyed in the earthquake in the late 1800s. Our next visit was NEIGRIHMS. It is the branch of AIIMS (All India Institute of Medical Science), Delhi. It is the only hospital of its kind in the North East India. Our next visit was the Ward Lake. This is a small lake, right in the middle of the City, very close to the St. Anthony's College. We thoroughly enjoyed the boat rides! Day: 6th January, 2013
